

Referee Field Training

Want to improve your referee skills?

Region 55 will be holding special Referee Field Training clinics this Fall. This training program is designed for new Regional level referees, returning Regional level referees who have been refing for 1 or 2 years, or for any Regional level referee who wants formalized field training that is unavailable in the Regional referee class.



The training program will consist of the following parts.

- Approximately 1 hour of instruction on the referee team, diagonal system of control, referee positioning and signaling, and assistant referee positioning and signaling.
- At least four, 3-person referee teams will be assembled and each team will referee 1/4 of a scrimmage game. **You should come to this clinic in your referee uniform so you can participate in the scrimmage game.**
- Teams will be de-briefed by referee instructors after the game. We will tell you what you did right and what areas you need to improve in.

This is a great opportunity to learn field techniques from certified referee instructors and veteran referees. Clinic dates are listed below.
